**TOURNAMENT RULES**

1. Entrants must be members in good standing in the Department of Illinois American Legion, American Legion Auxiliary, or the S.A.L. and 17 years or over
2. USGA Rules will apply except as announced by the Golf Committee or the Pro of the University of Illinois Golf Course.
3. Play will be 36 Holes. 18 Holes on Saturday and 18 Holes on Sunday on alternating courses of the University of Illinois.
4. Players will be placed in flights for individual competition by the committee. Winners will be determined in each flight scratch.
5. Entry Fee of \$115.00 must accompany Entry Form; this includes Green Fees and Golf Cart for both days of play.
6. Entry Fee and Entry Form must be received by the Golf Committee not later than May 15, 2012. Checks must be payable to "**Department of Illinois Golf Tournament**", and mailed **to RON SHIRLEY, 2002 OLA DR. CHAMPAIGN, ILLINOIS 61821. Phone # 217 359-6502.**

7. Tee times may be requested, consideration will be first come first serve, but the Committee will have the final say.
8. Prizes and awards will be passed out at the conclusion of the tournament at the banquet. PLEASE make arrangements to pick up awards, they will not be mailed
9. Please note a go to person that I can call in a foursome or a group to inform of tee times or other information.
10. Again this year we will be adding a some flights for our senior citizens. The age breaks will be, over 65 for Seniors.  
**Note: Let me know every ones flight desires, Legion, SAL, Senior, or new for all golfers, so That I may up grade my records.**
11. Refunds will be pro rated after expenses that have been paid or ordered before the tournament.
12. We will also have a scramble starting in 2012 that will include the Auxiliary in our tournament.  
With the scramble format we may have a shot gun start for the scramble only. To be determined by the committee.
13. Teams will consist of four (4) people. In scramble mode everyone will hit a tee shot, the team will then choose witch ball to play, then everyone will hit there second shoot From that point, until the ball is in the hole. One score is recorded for the entire team. Play will be from the same tees that are being used for all aspects of the tournament Scramble teams can be any four (4) members of the American Legion, American Legion Auxiliary, or the SAL Prizes for the Scramble will be determined by the committee.  
We hope that this format will increase the interest in the golf tournament to others without taking away the individual play that we have strived for in the past 36 years.
