This year we will have our normal scratch tournament with flights and we will be adding a scramble. I am happy to invite the Auxiliary to participate for the first time. **THE FOUR PERSON TEAMS** can consist of any combination of the Legion Family, example-2 legionnaire, 1 SAL, and Auxiliary or 2 SAL, and 2 Auxiliary, or 4 legionnaire constitute a team. The scramble rules are; each person hits a drive and the team picks which ever ball they want to play, then every one hits from that ball location, and then proceeds forward. Upon reaching the green, the first person putts, as soon as the ball goes into the hole you record that score and proceed to the next hole. You will only record one (1) score per team. The scramble will be a shot gun start that will be based on the number of teams in the scramble. We will have a prize for each combination of team. Examples of teams are as follows: all Legionnaire, all SAL, all Auxiliary, mixed Legion and SAL or auxiliary. **\$115.00 Per person**; that's for Two (2) rounds of golf, riding cart for both days, give a ways deemed from the State Golf Committee, usually caps, towels, and golf tees to each golfer. The banquet on Sunday at Post 24 you will have your choice of Chicken breast or riby steak, potato, and salad. Trophies will be given to the scratch tournament, but we are undecided to the prizes for the scramble. There will be betting holes on both courses with proceeds going to legion projects, by the golf committee. We will also have a raffle for some giveaways.
